Under authority of section 10 of *An Act to Amend the Election Act (No. 2)* Stats. P.E.I. 2003, 4th Session, c. 34 Council ordered that a Proclamation do issue proclaiming "*An Act to Amend the Election Act (No. 2)*" to come into force effective 17 June 2003.

2. by deleting the words "East Prince Regional Authority" and substituting the words "East Prince Health Region;"
3. by deleting the words "West Prince Regional Authority" and substituting the words "West Prince Health Region;"
4. by adding the following reporting entities:
  - (a) Kings Health Region
  - (b) Provincial Health Services Authority.

Pursuant to section 21 of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5 Council determined that, upon transfer of administration and control to Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, land and land covered by water located at Northport in Lot 5, Prince County, Prince Edward Island, totalling approximately eighteen decimal four eight (18.48) acres and currently owned by the Government of Prince Edward Island, as represented by the Minister of Transportation and Public Works, NOT be identified for non-development use under the Land Identification Program established by the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95).

A copy of the legal description of the said land and land covered by water is attached to the file copy of this Order in the Office of the Clerk of the Executive Council.

WHEREAS in and by section 10 of Chapter 34 of the Acts passed by the  
Legislature of Prince Edward Island in the 4th Session thereof held in the year  
2003 and in the fifty-second year of Our Reign intituled "An Act to Amend the  
Election Act (No. 2)" it is enacted as follows:

“This Act comes into force on a date that may be fixed by proclamation of the  
Lieutenant Governor in Council.”,

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act, Stats. P.E.I. 2003,  
4th Session, c. 34 should come into force on the seventeenth day of June, 2003,

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice and consent of our  
Executive Council for Prince Edward Island, do by this Our Proclamation  
ORDER AND DECLARE that the said Act being "An Act to Amend the Election  
Act (No. 2)" passed in the fifty-second year of Our Reign shall come into force on  
the seventeenth day of June, two thousand and three of which all persons  
concerned are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Patent and the Great Seal of Prince Edward Island to be hereunto affixed.
