EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ACT

 AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT  
 (AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE OF CIRCUMSTANCE

 THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

Pursuant to clause 10(a) of the *Executive Council Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-12 Council authorized the Attorney General to enter into an agreement with the Government of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Industry, to provide for the disclosure of data on the circumstance of death by the Chief Coroner for Prince Edward Island to Statistics Canada, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement. Council noted that disclosure of this data is subject to s.39 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-15-01. Further, Council noted that a national data base of information on all deaths investigated by the Chief Coroners and Chief Medical Examiners of the provinces and territories will be used to identify statistical trends in underlying causes of death across jurisdictions, with the objective of contributing to a decrease in preventable deaths across Canada.

PROVINCIALY OWNED LAND AT MURRAY HARBOUR, KINGS  
COUNTY  
EXEMPTION FROM  
IDENTIFICATION FOR NON-DEVELOPMENT USE

Pursuant to section 21 of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5 Council determined that, upon transfer of administration and control to Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, land and land covered by water located at Murray Harbour, in Lot 13, Kings County, Prince Edward Island, totalling approximately five decimal one (5.1) acres and currently owned by the Government of Prince Edward Island, as represented by the Minister of Transportation and Public Works, NOT be identified for non-development use under the Land Identification Program established by the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95).
