

EC2009-88**AN ACT TO AMEND THE LOTTERIES COMMISSION ACT
DECLARATION RE**

Under authority of section 3 of *An Act to Amend the Lotteries Commission Act* Stats. P.E.I. 2008, 2nd Session, c. 52, Council ordered that a Proclamation do issue proclaiming the said "An Act to Amend the Lotteries Commission Act" to come into force effective 31 March 2009.

EC2009-89**LOTTERIES COMMISSION ACT
GAMING CENTERS CONTROL REGULATIONS
AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to section 15 of the *Lotteries Commission Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-17, Council made the following regulations:

1. Section 9 of the *Lotteries Commission Act* Gaming Centers Control Regulations (EC409/05) is amended by the addition of the following after subsection (6):

(7) The following forms of identification are prescribed for the purposes of subsection 17(4) of the Act: Identification

- (a) a P.E.I. driver's license;
- (b) a provincial photographic identification card;
- (c) a passport, Certificate of Canadian Citizenship or permanent resident certificate issued by the federal government;
- (d) any other document issued by the federal government or the government of a province or territory that contains the person's photograph, date of birth and signature.

2. These regulations come into force on March 31, 2009.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The amendment provides for the forms of identification that are prescribed by the Act to prove a person is 19 years of age or older (in respect of the prohibition on the sale of lottery tickets to minors).

EC2009-90**POLICE ACT
PROVINCIAL POLICE CONSTABLE
