PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND  
LANDS PROTECTION ACT  
PROPERTY NO. 131920, LOT 35, QUEENS COUNTY  
IDENTIFICATION FOR NON-DEVELOPMENT USE  
AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use made pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in respect of approximately ninety (90) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 131920 located at Bedford, Lot 35, Queens County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by Deborah Marie (Mullen) Gallant of Ten Mile House, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that the property will continue to be identified for non-development use, but this amendment will permit the establishment and operation of a cellular tower on approximately eight (8) acres of the property.

This Order-in-Council comes into force on November 18, 2014.

**REGULATED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT  
PRACTICE OF PHARMACISTS AND PHARMACY  
TECHNICIANS REGULATIONS  
AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to section 2 and subsection 96(1) of the *Regulated Health Professions Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-10.1, Council made the following regulations:

**1. (1) Subsection 13(1) of the *Regulated Health Professions Act Practice of Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians Regulations* (EC532/14) is amended by the deletion of the words “subsections (3) and (5)” and the substitution of the words “subsection (5)”.**

**(2) Subsection 13(2) of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words “Subject to subsection (3), no” and the substitution of the word “No”.**

**(3) Subsection 13(3) of the regulations is revoked.**

**2. These regulations come into force on November 29, 2014.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** amends section 13 of the regulations by revoking subsection 13(3) and deleting references to that subsection in subsections 13(1) and (2).

**SECTION 2** provides for the commencement of these regulations.
