**1. Subsections 50.9(1) and (4) of the *Liquor Control Act* Regulations (EC704/75) are amended by the deletion of the words "\$150" and the substitution of the words "\$50".**

**2. These regulations come into force on September 3, 2016.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** reduces the fee to obtain and renew a package sales license from \$150 to \$50.

**SECTION 2** provides for the commencement of these regulations.
