Pursuant to clause 10(a) of the *Executive Council Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-12 Council authorized the Minister of Transportation, Infrastructure and Energy to enter into an Amending Agreement No. 2 with the Government of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure and Communities to establish the terms and conditions of contribution funding for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program, for the period April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2028, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.
