Certificate 6  an additional thirty (30) semester hours of study beyond a Certificate 5 and a master's degree in education or a master's degree in a professional area related to education and/ or in subject areas related to the authorized PEI curriculum that has been approved by the Registrar	180 credit hours minimum with a masters degree			
Certificate 7*  an additional thirty (30) semester hours of study beyond a Certificate 6 and an additional master's degree or doctoral degree in education or in a professional or subject area that relates directly to the P.E.I. public school system and that has been approved by the Registrar	210 credit hours minimum
