

## What is covered?

The Provincial Dental Care Program covers:

1. Annual and emergency dental examination,
2. Dental fillings (and limited root canal treatment),
3. Dental extractions,
4. Limited preventative services.
5. Dentures (removable dentures).

Covered Services	How often/Limitation
Annual exam	Once a year
Emergency exam	As required
Cleaning	Once a year
Sealants	Only children when required
Fluoride	Only children and those over 55 years of age
Fillings	One filling per tooth per year
Root canal	Special circumstances
Extraction	As required
Dentures	Once in ten years. You may be required to pay all laboratory fees
In-hospital care or nitrous sedation	As required

# Provincial Dental Care Program

## Who is covered?

Prince Edward Island residents and their dependents (including residents in a Long Term Care/Community Care facilities) who have an active PEI Health Card, and:

- Are receiving Social Assistance/Assured Income from the Department of Social Development and Housing.

OR

- Meet the financial threshold for your family size—see Table.

→ You are required to provide **consent** for Health PEI to receive their financial information directly from Canada Revenue Agency.
